At 29th July the everyday Acct was sitting at \$20,980.76 and past events like Xmas in July etc which were "user pay" have been accounted for. (i.e monies in equal monies out).

Please don't forget about the "Shannon's" we still have three tickets available to members, your club has picked up the tab for these, I'd hate to see them go to waste, ergo if not claimed very soon I'll offer them to all comers.

Now for my usual rant: "Historic Registration" - if you are on "H Plates", you must be aware that Rego & Green Slip etc are only valid as long as your car's Rego is CONCURRENT with your club membership. ALL memberships are now one month overdue - yes they fall due 1st June and we allow up to 31st July for members to get accounts up to date. Please be advised it is NOT the function of the Club's Historic Plates Registrar to collect payments or monies from members, either pay direct into our Acct or attent a meeting and pay cash.

Now something new: In general, a physical receipt for your club renewal is provided by your bank when you do a direct payment for renewals. Hence we don't now write them. However after some complaints and discussions, we have decided to issue receipts for "H-Plate" members. Whilst I was against this for reasons of effort required and additional cost, I must agree that a receipt could be required for "H-Plate" Members to prove valid current club membership, especially when stopped by over zealous Police or RTA inspectors. To this end a new receipt is being designed complete with Club, Your Name, Membership #, date paid and year of currency.

A wise person would keep this with his/her car's log book ready to produce upon demand. And NO they are not ready yet, but stay tuned. Also it just came to me that this receipt will only cover the Member whose car is also in his/her name. I think I've vented enough for now, maybe a good time to go on a South Seas Cruise - bye.


