The Committee can discuss this proposal and let the members take a vote.

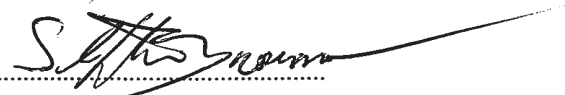

Results for June '26 are as follows:

Open: \$45,906.78 Credits: \$8,159.00 this is made up of two (2) new members \$200 and the remaining ~\$8K made up of renewals and Code26 payments.

Whilst Debits total \$3,132.38 being for the following:

\$1200 Mag, \$168.50 Ink/Binders, \$178.80 Post, \$5.10 Extra Post, \$552 Gosford RSL, \$100 Refund Sam Drey, \$500.01 M'Badges D/W Rowley, \$407.97 Monkey Door Prizes D/W Rowley, Acct Fee \$20.
Closing at 30th Jun'26 \$50,933.40.

The above means that July'26 Opens at \$50,933.40 and at time of printing your account stood at \$50,453.40 which was Code 26 and Renewals less the final payment to Gosford RSL of \$2,208.00, with several days to go and members realising they have not renewed and therefore driving an unregistered Corvette, I'm sure the final figures for end of July '26 will be a few hundred higher.

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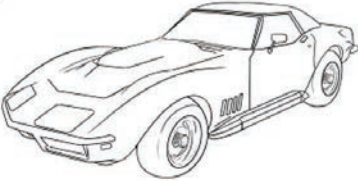
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National Corvette Museum Opens New Grand Sport Exhibit

The National Corvette Museum in Bowling Green, KY just added a new exhibit featuring the Chevrolet Grand Sport! Visitors will be able to view the new C8 Corvette Grand Sport decked out in its Admiral Blue exterior with a White racing strip and Red hash marks while a dipped Adrenaline Red interior awaits its driver.

The new exhibit is parked at the entrance to the Museum exhibits and it's one of the first displays that will be seen by visitors. Joining the newest C8 Grand Sport on display is a 1963 Grand Sport replica that represents the five original 1963 Grand Sports built by Zora Arkus-Duntov.
