All discounted rates will be available to the Vette guests up until the 29th February, subject to availability, and the preferred form of booking would be over the hotel website.





# From the Trea\$ury

Well another year has gone and for some reason I'm still the club Treasurer, this situation will only last till next June when for a lot of reasons I'll be retiring and thus allow another member to take on this role.

I'm currently the Treas, the P.O box emptier, the mag pick up service, the Enveloper, the Addresser, and Poster of mags. This situation has come about primarily due to Covid19, but now must be resolved into a more affable situation which will involve more hands on deck. Currently I believe the above situation is compounded by our choice of meeting sites. In the past other venues had better space and facilities which enabled some of our wives/members to do the enveloping, addressing etc whilst the meeting was conducted; the current site is serving a standby service but, meals, noise not to mention insufficient lighting is wearing thin. #### Some quick figures:

July Opens \$6436 + Credits \$5396 - \$Debits \$4755.

The above reflects Renewals, but the Debits is higher than usual and includes new caps \$574, Apparel \$2772 and Xmas Cruise \$1273 of couse the Cruise was fully subscribed by members attending. So feel free to jump in and get a new Hat and Shirt.

August Opens \$7077 + Credits \$1355 - Debits \$1290

Back to a more normal month with Renewals and print \$975, Post \$185 and Raffle prizes \$110.

Sept Opens \$7141 +Credits \$195 -Debits \$1350 this number includes the Port and the trophies for our last Show&Shine although we have a few left over for next time. Oh! and I had one Deposit I thought would go into the "Doug's Lobster Dinner Fund" of \$120 with the ref field saying "Cash Deposit" from ????????? well with Jorges help it may be a new member down the South Coast, (maybe) Please remember to put your "Surname" in the "Ref Field", if paying at a bank, demand the teller puts your name in, they can do it.






