MACARTHUR TRAIN STATION I

Hello Members,

The following is a quick overview of the Auto shifter display within the centre console. This pic (C4 90) is the display part removed, cleaned, showing the four main parts, metal holder, black backing plate, plastic fascia and the sliding pointer. The holder contains these parts and normally one globe and screws to the underside of the centre console.





Pic No. 2 shows how the slide pointer is sandwiched between the plate and fascia. It slides along indicating the selected gear function. You can see the holder has two (2) lamp hole positions, but the wiring loom has only one bulb holder fitted. Note the tangs of the pointer which engage with the drive pin on the shifter, it just slots over this pin and as the shifter is moved from P through R,N,OD,D,2 & 1 it slides and gives visual indication of gear selected.

The third pic is the four parts placed together ready for fixing to the underside of the shifter console. Note the plastic piece with the gear indications has end tongues moulded at $\sim 90^{\circ}$ and coloured orange. This



allows the light to enter the plastic and makes the letters/numbers glow.

The final pic shows the Shifter mech, note the bright steel pin sticking out near the top of the return spring. This layout is virtually the same format for 84~89 with a slightly different plastic display, whilst this one should cover 90~96. From memory this layout is either the same or very similar to the early Commodore. If you can't see your indicator needle, it may be either missing, broken or when the converter rushed it back together they failed to correctly slot the pin into display needle tangs and it has been slid past its endstop and out of sight. The console plate can be lifted at the centre glov-



box end after removing a few screws and with long thin fingers, slid under the pass (LH) side. If the slider is in situ then it's just a matter of pulling shifter back and aligning the pin and tangs to engage, replace all and 'Wallah' - job done. This is not a hard job nor does it require any special tools, BUT, (there is always a but!), take it slowly and carefully. After all, it's now nearly or over 30 years old!. Regards, Vettech.






