



Some will note that a long-time advertiser on our back page is no longer with use. For the moment we will randomly select each month one of our larger advertisers to occupy this prime position as a thank you for their on-going support.

My discussions with other clubs to investigate the magazine issues, have shown they are in the same boat and some have gone 100% electronic whilst others have opted for six (6) monthly. A big thanks goes out to those who responded to my editorial last month, especially our Editor Karin Ross, who has supplied some alternatives for consideration.


