
Friday 19 - Sunday 21 April - MEAT STOCK HOMEBUSH

ATTENTION ALL MEMBERS

It's that time of the year again - YES, membership renewal time for the 24/25 financial year. Remember if you are on 'H' Plates then by law you are required to have concurrent membership and Rego.

Simple and easy, deposit the grand sum of \$75 into the club's account making sure to put your surname in the 'reference' field.

NOW, in this magazine there are several extra but loose-leaf pages; one is for renewal, BUT if your details have not changed, then lucky you, you don't need to fill it out as the Secretary will continue with your details in her membership log. This is the same log that police and RTA check when the need arises!

The best method of payment is via 'Direct Bank Deposit' and lucky for you, our bank details are on the bottom right-hand corner of page 3 of the magazine. This payment will generate a receipt for you which you should attach to your car's logbook as proof of club membership, (you need to print it off).


General Business
